This letter verifies that Alexandria City High School PTA is herein recognized as a subordinate of the Virginia Congress of Parents and Teachers ("Virginia PTA"). The EIN on record for Alexandria City High School PTA is 541303279. Virginia PTA's Group Exemption Number (GEN) is 3229 and our sequence number is 26006.

As a subordinate organization, your local PTA is included in the Virginia PTA corporation filing with the Virginia State Corporation Commission under number #00266536 and with the Virginia Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (VDACS). This enables your local PTA to fundraise, solicit charitable contributions, host charitable gaming activities, raffles, and the like in the Commonwealth of Virginia.

In order to maintain affiliation with Virginia PTA and the benefits provided, your PTA must abide by the <u>annual</u> <u>Standards of Affiliation</u> outlined in the Local Unit Uniform Bylaws. As a parent organization, Virginia PTA has a duty of care and fiduciary responsibility to ensure local PTAs adhere to legal requirements and <u>IRS 501(c)</u> <u>regulations.</u> As such, Virginia PTA's staff and Vice President of Local Unit Operations monitors Standards of Affiliation compliance for all PTAs in the Commonwealth of Virginia. Additionally, Council PTAs review compliance reports for PTAs in their city/county and provide direct outreach and local assistance to maintain full good standing.

In the event a local PTA repeatedly fails to meet the minimum annual Standards of Affiliation, the local unit PTA executive committee and appropriate school administration officials will be notified in writing of the intent to revoke the PTA's charter with Virginia PTA.
